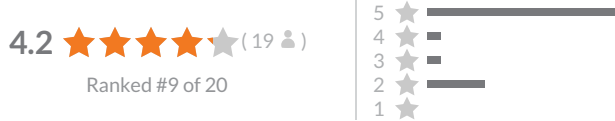
We do not have a vibrant village, most of the buildings and infrastructure are not cared for, or have remote landlords. It looks badly maintained for

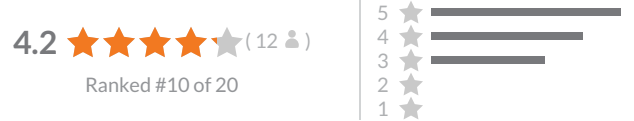
The community gets it's unique character from the surrounding forests/rural feel. What is remaining needs to be protected, as so much has been logged.

We moved to Lantzville because it was not like North Nanaimo. Now we are concerned that it will be just like it. A great opportunity was lost.

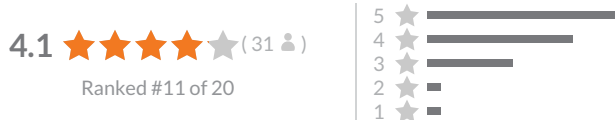


Revitalize the 2 blocks of downtown

Plant some trees

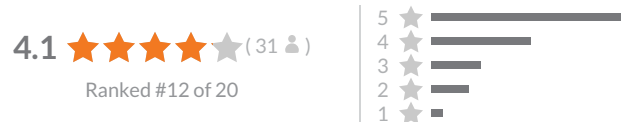


Beautify the village core - make it a cohesive theme. Make it easy to park vehicles and walk.

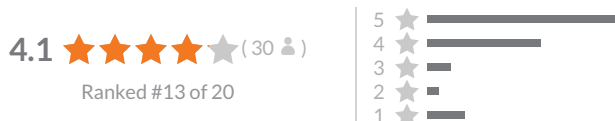


Give people of all ages a reason to visit the village. Such as unique stores e.g. old fashion candy store, ice cream parlour. Pub is a great example.

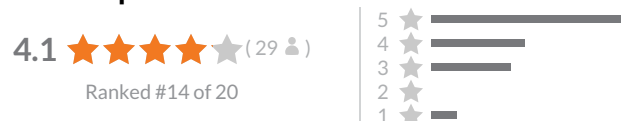
The demographic is ageing and we need a diverse group of residents to make a vibrant community. We need unique stores with living areas above.



Sidewalks



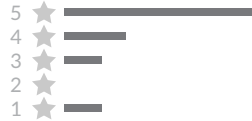

So kids and adults can walk safely to and from the school, village and their homes.

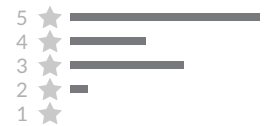

Without this citizens and visitors will get used to going to Nanaimo, and there will eventually be no need for a village core.

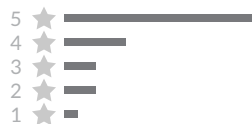
